#### 2 **30 Rock**

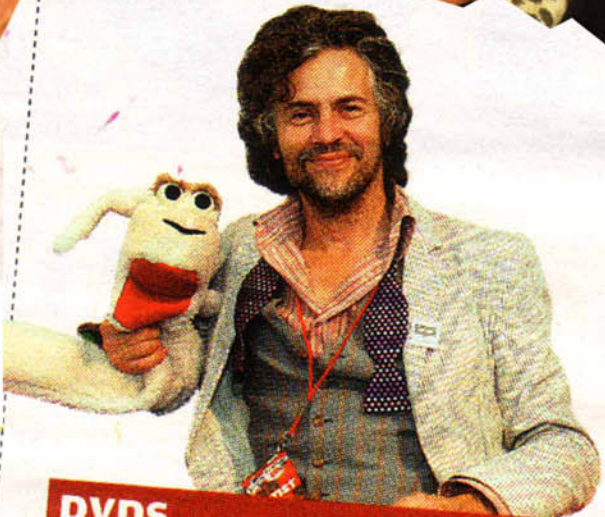
